**Avoid all distractions while driving. Stay focused on how you're driving when near large trucks.**

**Don't test or antagonize truck drivers. Semi truck drivers log thousands of miles each week and need to stay focused.**



**Remember trucks brake early and make wide turns. Never underestimate the amount of space a truck needs to slow down or turn.**
